Lauluraamatukomisjon võttis alates esimesest koosolekust 16.05.2017 selge suuna laiema ringi inimeste kaasamiseks lauluraamatu koostamisel.

- Korraldati fookusgrupiintervjuusid;
- Viidi läbi kaks küsitlust:
- Koguti erinevate lauluraamatute analüüse – kokku üle kahekümne lauluraamatu erinevatest riikidest:
- Korraldati lauluraamatukonverents 26.– 27.10. 2018 Tartus;
- Tutvustati kontseptsiooni kavandit 22.01.2019. vaimulike konverentsil ja 29.04.2019 kirikukogul;
- Avaldati mitmeid artikleid ja tehti raadiosaateid;
- Esitati EELK konsistooriumi 02.04.2019 otsuse nr 19 alusel kontseptsiooni esimene kavand avalikule arutelule, mille käigus püüdis komisjon kaasata diskussiooni võimalikult laia ringi spetsialiste ja koguduste liikmeid;
- Esitati lisaks avalikele üleskutsetele nimeline palve tagasiside saamiseks enam kui kolmekümnele vaimulikule, muusikule ja teiste relevantsetele valdkondade asjatundjatele.

Tänu erinevatele kaasavatele tegevustele on juba praeguseks olemas märkimisväärne hulk inimesi (hinnanguliselt umbes 500), kes on andnud oma panuse lauluraamatu koostamisse.

Komisjoni üheks keskseks väljakutseks esimesel kahel tööaastal saigi lauluraamatu kontseptsiooni koostamine, mis valmis lõplikult 2019. aasta sügisel ning sama aasta novembris kirikukogul.

2020. aastal asuti lauluraamatu koostamisele kontseptsioonist lähtuvalt. Selleks võeti tööle 1.02.2020 projektijuht ning moodustati 11 toimkonda, kes kõik erinevatel teemadel kaastööd teevad.

Tulenevalt kontseptsioonist, võetakse uude raamatusse üle 400 laulu Kiriku laulu- ja palveraamatust ning lisatakse u 500 uut laulu, mille korje hetkel käib. Kui keegi soovib uute laulude osas ettepanekuid teha, siis need on oodatud aadressile laulud@eelk.ee

Lauluraamat peaks valmima 2025. aastal.

Prayer


We have congregation members that are going through difficult times, sickness, and ailing health. Please pray for them.

Confirmation / Leerikursus - 1st Class October 20th, 2024

Please register your interest in participating in the Confirmation program with the church office.

Confirmation completes Baptism. The confirmation program is intended to help individuals be mindful of their relationship with God, to understand and strengthen it, and to embrace living a Christian life - it is a meaningful journey, a rite of passage, an accomplishment to the benefit of the student, the family, and the church. It represents a personal commitment to grow in the knowledge, love, and practice of our faith through learning about the Bible, the Sacraments, Creed, Lord's Prayer, and the 10 Commandments. When you are confirmed, you gain a new identity as a full member of the Church.

Confirm – "kinnitamine" ütleb selgelt ära, et konfirmeerimisel midagi kinnitatakse. Leeriinstitutsiooni abil ehk leeritulekuga inimene, kes on väikese lapsena ristitud, tuleb ja kinnitab oma usku, kinnitab, et ta tahab elada ristiinimesena. See on tahte väljendamine ja selle kinnitamine.

Leeriõnnistamine on talitus, mille käigus leerikooli läbinud inimesed tunnistavad oma kristlikku usku apostliku usutunnistuse sõnadega ja kinnitavad, et soovivad elada ristiusu õpetuse järgi. Seejärel vaimulik õnnistab igat leerilast asetades käed tema pea peale ja tehes iga ühe üle ristimärgi.



GRIEFSHARE

St. Peter's is pleased to announce a special Grief-Share course and weekly support group for people grieving the loss of someone close, be it recently or many years ago. It is the perfect place for you to share your grief with those who are walking it too. GriefShare can help you cope during this most difficult time of life. Come on your own or with a friend. Make new friends in the group.

Led by a volunteer leader, each GriefShare meeting begins with a 30-minute video featuring respected experts on grief-related topics and helpful stories from people who have experienced loss. After the video, group members spend time discussing what was presented in the video and what is going on in their lives. Talking with other people who understand what you are experiencing brings great comfort,

helps to understand the grief experience, and offers a supportive environment to work through your grief.

The cost to attend is free, donations are always welcome. We ask that you bring a



snack that can be shared with the group. A Grief-Share workbook is strongly recommended which serves as a road map on your grief journey and helps you process your emotions, experiences and cope with your loss. The cost is \$ 30 US. The book can be ordered when you register.


